FROM THE TOWN COUNCILOR'S REPORT

(A.) \$650,000 HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE TOWN TO BE ALLOCATED TOWARDS THE BRIDGE STREET DRAW BRIDGE TO IMPROVE THE WORKINGS AND MECHANICS. WORK WILL BEGIN IN FALL '10/SPRING'11.

(B.) IN ADDITION, THE FAA HAS SPONSORED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE HYANNIS AIRPORT. THE TERMINAL WILL RECEIVE A COMPLETE MAKEOVER AND A SEPARATE TOWER WILL BE BUILT THIS SPRING/SUMMER.

(C.) OSTERVILLE WEST BARNSTABLE ROAD REPAIR COSTS WILL BE SUBMITTED IN NEXT YEAR'S BUDGET. THE FUTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE ROAD WILL INCLUDE A COMPLETE REBUILD.

HELP US MAKE COTACHESET PARK A REALITY!

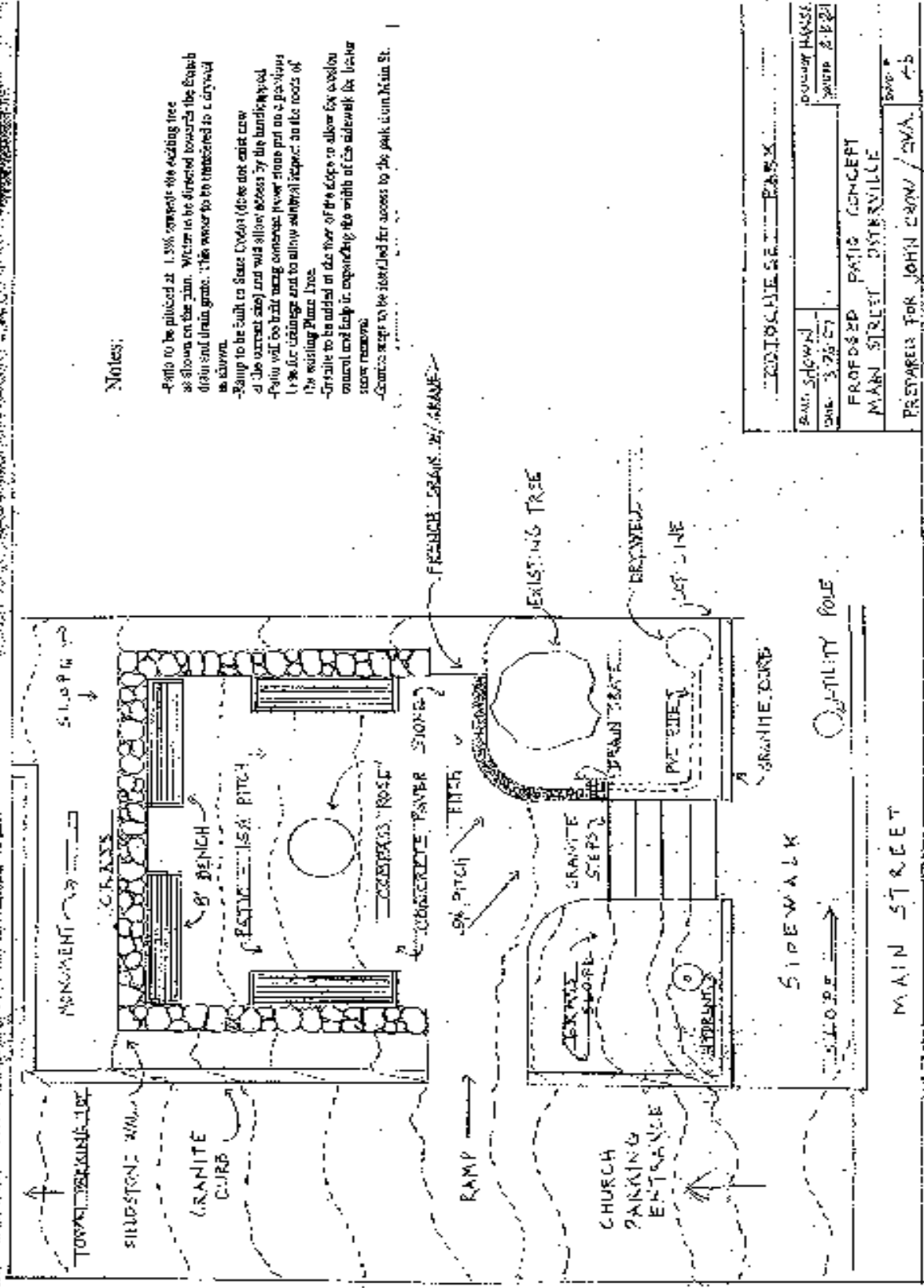
IN THE HEART OF OSTERVILLE VILLAGE, SHADED BENEATH A BEAUTIFUL GIANT SYCAMORE TREE, SITS ONE OF THE BEST SPOTS TO WHILE AWAY THE HOURS WATCHING THE WORLD GO BY ON MAIN STREET. YET THIS LOVELY SPOT IS POSSIBLY THE MOST OVERLOOKED AND NEGLECTED PLACE IN THE VILLAGE.

ON THE GREEN, BETWEEN THE ENTRANCES TO OSTERVILLE BAPTIST CHURCH AND 812 MAIN STREET, IS THE FUTURE LOCATION OF COTACHESET PARK. THIS SPRING, THE OSTERVILLE VILLAGE ASSOCIATION WILL BEGIN WORK TO TRANSFORM THIS HIDDEN GEM INTO ITS NEW FORM (LOCATED NEARBY IS THE CONCEPT PLAN SUBMITTED BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT AND OVA DIRECTOR, PETER HANSEN) AND WE CAN USE YOUR HELP TO MAKE IT HAPPEN.

Notes:

- Patio to be placed at 1.5% towards the existing tree as shown on the plan. Water to be directed towards the French drain and drain grate. This water to be directed to a drywell as shown.
- Ramp to be built to Stone Docks (does not exist now at the current site) and will allow access by the handicapped.
- Patio will be built using concrete. Power signs put on a post along the driveway and to allow electrical input. In the roots of the existing Stone Tree.
- Gravel to be added on the river of the slope to allow for gravel to be added to the width of the sidewalk for better snow removal.
- Gravel ramp to be installed for access to the park from Main St.
